

Tax Ordinance  
Ordinance No. 87

An Ordinance of the Borough of Clymer, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for the fiscal year 1938.

Be it ordained and enacted, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Clymer, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section I. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and occupations within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purpose for the fiscal year 1938 as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of ten (10) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

For debt purpose, the <sup>sum</sup> of four and half (4.5) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

For other purposes as follows:

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of fourteen and one half (14.5) mills.

Section II. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
