M. E.D. S. T. at the Fire Hall Clymer Pennsylvania, at which time and place objections thereto shall be heard.

ORDINANCE NO.111

Vacating a portion of Hickory Avenue between Rodney Street and Stockton Street in said Borough.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that a portion of Hickory Avenue between Rodney Street and Stockton Street in the Borough of Clymer, which is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a post on the western line of Rodney Street at corner common to the intersection of Hickory Avenue and Rodney Street; thence by line of Hickory Avenue North 52° East 212 feet to a post on Stockton Street; thence by line of said Stockton Street in a southeasterly direction 20 feet to a post; thence by line of said Hickory Avenue South 52° West 212 feet to a post on Rodney Street; thence by line of said Rodney Street; in a northwesterly direction 20 feet to the place of beginning. be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 11. That the Borough Engineer is hereby directed to change the adopted Borough map as herein indicated.

Section 111. That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed.
