

ORDINANCE NO. 118

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF GLYMER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1955.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Glymer, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and occupations within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1955, as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of seven and one-half ($7\frac{1}{2}$) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

For debt purposes the sum of two (2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of nine and one-half ($9\frac{1}{2}$) mills.

SECTION 2. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same id hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
