ORDINANCE NO. 119

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1956.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Clymer, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same as hereby levied on all property and occupations within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1956, as follows;

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of seven and $(7\frac{1}{2})$ one-half mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

For debt purpose the sum of two (2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of nine and one-half $(9\frac{1}{2})$ mills.

SECTION 2. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
