

ORDINANCE NO. 130.

PROHIBITING THE BURNING OF RUBBISH, REFUSE, GARBAGE, TRASH OR ANY SUBSTANCE WHICH CAUSES AN ODOR OR DENSE SMOKE AND PROVIDING FOR THE PENALTY THEREOF.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Borough Of Clymer, County of Indiana and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same:

SECTION I. That it shall be unlawful for any person, or persons, to build, cause or permit to be built, on any private or public property or any private or public road or alley within the Borough of Clymer any fire for the purpose of the burning of rubbish, refuse, or garbage, trash or any substance which causes an odor or dense smoke.

SECTION II. That any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance and being convicted thereof before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace of the Borough of Clymer shall pay a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00 and the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, shall undergo imprisonment in Indiana County Jail for a period of not more than 10 days.

SECTION III. all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
