

## ORDINANCE NO. 132

Amending Section 2 and Section 3 of Ordinance Number 89, Said Ordinance Number 89 Relates to Parking Meters and the Use of Parking Meters.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority if the same:

Section I. That paragraph 4 of section II of Ordinance Number 89 shall be and hereby is admended to read as follows:

The provision of this ordinance shall not apply between the hours of six P. M. in the evening untill nine A. M. the following morning of each week day except Saturday when the provisions of this ordinance shall not apply, between the hours of nine P. M. Saturday evening and nane A. M. the following Monday and this ordinance shall hot apply on holidays.

Section II. That the second paragraph of Section III of Ordinance Number 89 shall be and hereby is admended to read as follows:

Each officer shall also attach to such vehicle a notice to the owner or operator thereof that such vehicle has been parked in violation of the provision of this ordinance, specifying the offence. Said notice shall instruct the owner or operator that the sum of Twenty-Five (\$.25) Cents must be paid to the Burgess of the Borough of Clymer or must be placed in the envelope provided with said notice and deposited in containers attached to certain parking meters in the Borough of Clymer before six o'clock P. M. on the day of the violation except Saturdays, when the payment or deposit must be before nine o'clock P. M. That if payment as hererofore specified is not made, the owner or operator receiving such notice shall make the payment of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar to the Burgess of the Borough of Clymer within twentyfour (24) hours. That in defaultof payment as heretofore specified, the owner or operator receiving such notice shall be subject to arrest and upon conviction liable to pay a fine not to exceed Ten (10) Dollars plus costs or confinement in the Indiana County Jail for a peroid not to exceed ten (10) days. To a vehicle which occupies a metered parking space after a notice of violation has been attached without the owner or operator having deposited a coin or coing in the meter shall be attached additional notice of violation for each hour the vehicle remains so parked. For each such violation the owner or operator is liable to make the same payments or suffer the same penalties as heretofore provided for the initial violation.

Section III. All ordiances or parts of ordinances inconsisten herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
