

ORDINANCE NUMBER 136

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT PORTION OF SIXTH STREET DEDICATED ON THE OFFICIAL MAP OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER BUT UNOPENED, LYING BETWEEN THE INTERSECTION OF SIXTH AND PENN STREETS AND DIXON ROAD AND BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY LOTS NUMBER 8 AND 10 ON PENN STREET AND ON THE SOUTH BY AN UNNUMBERED TRACT OF LAND.

WHEREAS, there appears on the official Map of the Borough of Clymer a section of Sixth Street described as follows:

Beginning at the interseation of th East line of Dixon Road and the Northerly line of Sixth Street (unopened), thence North $80^{\circ} 45'$ East 51.97 feet to a point; thence South $50^{\circ} 15'$ East 149.87 feet to a point, the intersection of the West line of Penn Street and the Northerly line of Sixth Street (unopened); thence by a line through Sixth Street (unppened) South $9^{\circ} 15'$ East 91.45 feet to a point on the Southerly line of Sixth Street (unopened); thence North $50^{\circ} 15'$ West 204.76 feet to a point; thence South $80^{\circ} 45'$ West 15.7 feet to a point, the intersextion of the Southerly line of Sixth Street (unopened) and the East line of Dixon Road; thence along the East line of Dixon Road North $9^{\circ} 15'$ West 50 feet to the place of begining.

WHEREAS, said above described section of Sixth Street has never been opened and in the judgement of the Council of the Borough there wil arise no need to open said section of Sixth Street and it is necessary and proper to vacate said section of Sixth Street;

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Clymer, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. That the unopened section of Sixth Street lying between the intersection of Sixth Street and Penn Streets and Dixon Road, more fully described above, be vacated and that necessary legal steps be taken to make this action legally effective.
