

ORDINANCE NO. 138

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF GLYMER, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania fixing the tax rate for the fiscal year 1964

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Vouncil of the Borough of Glymer, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION I. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and occupations within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fical year 1964 as follows:

Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of (14) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

For dept purposes the sum of ( 1) mill on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Making a total tax rete for all Borough purposes of (15) mills.

SECTION II. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects yhis ordinance.
