

ORDINANCE No. 144

An Ordinance Approving and Establishing the Grades, Structures, and All Other Structures Appearing on the Plan of the Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, showing Proposed Improvement on Sixth Street & Penn Street in the Borough of Clymer Pennsylvania; Adopting the Said Plan as the Official Borough Plan for Said Street and providing for the removal of nonutility structures.

WHEREAS, The Department of Highways has submitted to the Borough Council of Clymer Borough a Plan showing proposed construction and change of grade of 66 a portion of State Highway Route No. 508 on Sixth-Street & Penn Street, from Station 0+00 to Sta. 11+03.33 to station 11+12.67 to Station 14+95 Bk. distance of 1495.00 feet, as shown by the said plan prepared and submitted by the Department of Highways, approved April 7, 1966, by the Chief Engineer of the Department of Highways.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the town Council of the Borough of Clymer and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, that the grades, drainage structures, and all other structures shown on the plan prepared and submitted by the Department of Highways as aforesaid, be, and the same are adopted, and are hereby enacted and ordained as and for the true and proper grades, drainage structures, and other structure of and for Sixth & Penn Street, as shown on the said plan, which is hereby adopted as the Official Borough Plan for the said street.

SECTION 2. The President of the Borough Council and the Mayor are hereby authorized to express the approval of the Borough to the change of grade of the aforesaid State Highway Route, by affixing their signatures, and the Borough Seal, to the said relocation plan.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its approval as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The Borough of Clymer Also agrees to adjust any existing manholes and other facilities, necessary during construction at it's own expense.
