

ORDINANCE NO. 151.

ORDINANCE RELATING TO PERMITS FOR INDIVIDUAL AND COMMUNITY SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, INDIANA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

The Borough of Clymer, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:

Section I. No person shall install an individual or community sewage disposal system or construct any building in the Borough of Clymer, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, in which the individual or community sewage system is to be installed or replaced without first obtaining a permit indicating the site, plans and specifications of such system are in compliance with the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," January 24, P.L. (1965), 1966, No. 537, and the rules and Regulations adopted pursuant to said Act. No parcel of land shall be excluded from the provisions of this Ordinance because of its size. A fee to be set each year shall be paid to the Borough Administrative Officer at the time of making an application for individual or community sewage disposal system.

Section II. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance or the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," January 24, P. L. (1965), 1966, No. 537, shall be subject to the penalties and restraining provisions set forth in the said Act.
