

ORDINANCE NO. 156

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE ELECTION OF BOROUGH AUDITORS AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF AN INDEPENDENT AUDITOR WHO SHALL BE A CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT REGISTERED IN PENNSYLVANIA OR A FIRM OF CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANTS SO REGISTERED.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Clymer, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That the office of Auditors elected by the electors of the Borough of Clymer be abolished and that in lieu thereof the Borough Council shall appoint an independent auditor who shall be a certified public accountant registered in Pennsylvania or a firm of certified public accountants so registered, to audit the books and accounts of the Borough according to law.

SECTION 2. Any ordinance or parts thereof conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the provisions affect this ordinance.
