

, ORDINANCE NO. 159

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING TRUCKS IN EXCESS OF SEVEN THOUAAND (7000) POUNDS GROSS WEIGHT, INDLUDING THE WEIGHT OF THE TRUCK WHEN LOADED, EXCEPT FOR LOCAL DELIVERIES, TO OPERATE OR TRAVEL IN EITHER DIRECTION ON ANY STREET OR STREETS IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, EXCEPT YWOSE STREETS WHICH ARE UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS.

BE OT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Clymer, and it is hereby orgained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That in order to prevent damage to the blacktop paved, concrete, brick or unpaved steets of the Borough of Clymer and in the interest of public safety, it shall be unlaful for any person or persons to operate a truck or trucks in excess of seven thousand (7000) pounds gross weight including the weight of the truck when loaded, except for local deliveries, in either direction on any street or streets in the Borough of Clymer, except those streets which are under the juerisdiction of the Pennsylvania Department of Highways, said streets being under the jurisdiction of the Pennsylvania Department of Highways being Route #286 and Route #403.

SECTION 2, Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction before the Mayor, Juxtice of the Peace or Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars nor more than Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars, together with costs of prosecution, and in default thereof shall undergo imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not to exceed ten (10) days.

SECTION 3, Any ordinance or parts thereof conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the provisions affect this ordinance.
