

ORDINANCE NO. 16

An Ordinance regulating the manner and construction of flues and chimneys, and providing penalty for violation thereof.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer in the County of Indiana and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. No stovepipe shall project through the side, end or roof of a house, or through a window or door of any house, shed or building within the Borough; and all flues and chimneys shall be carried up from the ground in a safe and secure manner. Through the buildings in which shall project through the roof, a safe and secure distance not less than three feet, so as not to set fire to or endanger the building in which they may stand or adjoining buildings.

Provided: however, in exceptional cases, upon application to Council, a permit may be granted to construct flues in a different manner, upon specifications to be approved by the Property Committee. Anyone violating the provisions of this section, shall forfeit and pay for every such offense, a fine or penalty of twenty dollars, and for every week he may continue the same, the further sum of twenty dollars, and upon judgment against any person by summary conviction of violation of this ordinance, or by proceedings by summons, on default of payment of fine or penalty imposed by said judgment and the costs. The defendant shall be sentenced and committed to the county jail for a period not exceeding thirty days.

Ordained and enacted by the Town Council lawfully assembled in said Borough, this 20th day of July, 1908.
