

## ORDINANCE NO. 160

VACATING OF EIGHTH STREET BETWEEN MORRIS STREET AND OAK AVENUE  
IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, INDIANA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

SECTION 1: BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town  
Council of the Borough of Clymer and it is hereby enacted and  
ordained by the authority of the same that a portion of Eighth  
Street between morris Street and Oak Avenue in the Borough  
of Clymer, which is more parricularly described as follows:

BEGINING at a post on the western line of  
Eighth Street at the intersection of Morris  
Street and Eighth Street at corner of Lot  
No. 108 on Morris Street; thence by line of  
Lot No. 108 North 50° 15' West 150 feet to a  
point on Oak Street; thence by line of said Oak  
Street North 39° 45' East 50 feet to a point on  
line of Lot No. 106; thence by line of Lot No. 106  
South 50° 15' East 150 feet to a point om the north  
line of Morris Street; thence by the north line of  
Morris Street South 39° 45' West 50 feet to the  
place of beginning.

be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2: That the Borough Manager is hereby directed  
to change the adopted Borough Map as herein indicated.

SECTION 3: That any Ordinance or part of Ordinance  
conflicting with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.
