

ORDINANCE No 161

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA
FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1971.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained by the
Council of the Borough of Clymer, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania;

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all
property and occupations within the said Borough subject to
taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1971 as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of
fifteen (15) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation:

Making a total take rate for all Borough purposes of
fifteen (15) mills.

SECTION 2. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance,
conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby
repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
