

ORDINANCE NO. 164

VACATING OF ELDER AVENUE BETWEEN LOT NO. 254 ON DIXON ROAD AND LOT NO. 264 ON DIXON ROAD IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, INDIANA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

SECTION 1: BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that a portion of Elder Avenue between Lot No. 254 on Dixon Road through Lot No. 264 on Dixon Road in the Borough of Clymer, which is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the southern line of Elder Avenue at corner common to Lot No. 254 on Dixon Road and an unnamed alley; thence by the southern line of Elder Avenue South 78° 55' West 300 feet to a point at the eastern line of Lot No. 266; thence North 11° 05" West 16 feet to a point; thence by the northern line of Elder Avenue North 78° 55" East 300 feet to a point on an unnamed alley; thence South 11° 05" East 16 feet to the place of beginning.

be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2; That the Borough Manager is hereby directed to change the adopted Borough Map as herein indicated.

SECTION 3; That any Ordinance or part of Ordinance conflicting with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.
