

ORDINANCE No. 166

AN ORDINANCE OF BOROUGH OF CLYMER SIGNIFYING THE DESIRE AND INTENTION OF SAID BOROUGH TO ORGANIZE AN AUTHORITY UNDER THE MUNICIPALITY ACT OF 1945 SETTING FORTH THE PROPOSED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CLYMER BOROUGH SEWER AUTHORITY. AUTHORIZING THE PROPER OFFICERS OF THE BOROUGH TO EXECUTE SAID ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR AND ON ITS BEHALF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Clymer in the County of Indiana, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I That it is ~~also~~ the desire of the said Borough Council of Clymer Borough in the County of Indiana, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and said Council hereby signifies its intention to organize a Municipal Authority under the Municipality Authorities Act of May 2nd. One Thousand Nine Hundred Fourty-Five, P.L. 382 as amended.

SECTION II That in pursuance of said desire and intencioⁿ and conformity with the terms and provisions of said Municipality Authorities Act and its amendments, the proposed Articles of Incorporation are hereby set forth in full as follows:

In compliance with the requirements of the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945 approved the second day of May 1945 P.L. 382, as amended and pursuant to an ordinance adopted by the proper authorities of the Borough of Clymer, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, that a Municipal Authority be established under the provisions of the aforementioned law the Borough of Clymer, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, desiring that a Municipal Authority be established and that a Certificate of Incorporation be issued to said Authority, does hereby certify:

(a) The name of the Authority shall be:

CLYMER BOROUGH SEWER AUTHORITY

(b) The Authority is formed under the Act of May 2, 1945. P.L. 382 as amended.

(c) No Authorities have been created by the Borough of Clymer under the Act of 1945 May 2 P.L. 382 as amended or the Act of 1935, June 28. P. L. 463.

(d) The name of the incorporating municipality is:

All of whom are taxpayers in, Maintain a business and or are citizens of the Borough of Clymer.

(f) The Authority shall be for the purpose of acquiring, holding, constructing, improving, maintaining and operating, owning, leasing, either in the capacity ~~and~~ of lesser or lessee, projects of the following kind and character, to-wit: building and structures to be devoted wholly or partially for public use and for revenue purposes, sewers, sewer systems or part thereof, sewage treatment works including works for treating and disposing of industrial waste ~~facilitues~~ and equipment for the collection, removal ~~of~~ disposal of ashes, garbage, rubbish and other ~~fr-~~ refuse materials by incineration, land fill or other methods, and all facilities in ~~use~~ any way used, useful, necessary, convenient or incidental to the ~~furthrance~~ and operation of such projects.

(g) The several officers of the Borough are hereby authorized and directed to do and perform every lawful, requisite and convenient thing for the organization of the said Authority which is provided and authorized by the said Act of 1945.

SECTION III. The proposed Articles of Incorporation of said Authority shall be executed by and on behalf of the Borough of Clymer by the President of the Borough Council the seal of said Borough shall be thereto affixed and attested by the Secretary of Council and approved by the Mayor. The Soliciter is authorized and directed to cause to be published the Notice of Intention to file the Articles of Incorporation as required by the aforementioned Act, and when said Articles of Incorporation are properly excuted by the incorporating municipality, the same shall be filed with the Secretary of the Commonwealth.

SECTION IV. All ordinances or parts of ordinances not in accord with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
