

## ORDINANCE No. 167

LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING AS A PUBLIC AVENUE IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, AN AVENUE DESIGNATED AS PEACH AVENUE AND FIXING AND REGULATING THE WIDTH AND GRADE THEREOF.

SECTION 1; BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that the following Avenue, which is hereby designated as Peach Avenue, is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public avenue in the Borough of Clymer, which is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINING at a point in the northern line of Walcott Street at the southeastern corner of Lot #14 on said Street; thence by the western line of said Lot #14, 150 feet to the southern line of Walnut Avenue; thence by the southern line of Walnut Avenue in an westerly direction 16 feet to a point on the western line of Lot 61 on First Street; thence by the western line of Lots #61, #63, and #65 on First Street, 150 feet to the northern line of Walcott Street; thence by the northern line of Walcott Street, 16 feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. That the grade of said Avenue beginning at the intersection of said Avenue with Walcott Street and proceeding in a northerly direction for 150 feet shall be a descending grade of approximately three (3%) per centum from Walcott Street in a northerly direction to Walnut Avenue.

SECTION 3. The said Avenue shall consist of a central roadway for vehicular traffic sixteen (16) feet in width.

SECTION 4; That the Borough Manager is hereby directed to change the adopted Borough Map as herein indicated.

SECTION 5. That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with this ordinance is hereby repealed.
