

ORDINANCE No. 168

VACATING A PORTION OF POPLAR AVENUE WHERE IT INTERSECTS WITH MAPLE AVENUE IN A SOUTHERLY DIRECTION TO THE BOROUGH LINE.

SECTION I. Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Glymer and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the same that a portion of Poplar Avenue where it intersects with Maple Avenue in a southerly direction to the Borough line which is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINING at the southeastern corner of the intersection of Maple Avenue and Poplar Avenue on line of Lot #84; thence in a southerly direction 130 feet, more or less, along Lot #84 to the Borough line; thence in a westerly direction 16 feet to Lot # 86; thence by line of Lot #86 in a northerly direction 100 feet, more or less, to the southern line of Maple Avenue; thence by the southern line of Maple Avenue in an easterly direction 16 feet to the place of beginning.

be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION II. That the Borough Engineer is directed to change the adopted Borough Map as herin indicated.

SECTION III. That any ordinance or part of Ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (20) days after the date hereof.
