

ORDINANCE NO. 170

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION, AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough of Clymer:

SECTION 1. One-way streets: The following are hereby established as one-way streets:

1. Oak Avenue from Sixth Street to Fifth Street.
2. Cherry Avenue from Morris Street to Franklin Street.

SECTION 2. All vehicular traffic entering Franklin Street from Cherry Avenue must make a right turn.

SECTION 3. Penalty for Violation: Any person who shall violate any provision of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than two-dollars (\$2.00) or more than ten dollars (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than five (5) days .

That any ordinance or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
