

ORDINANCE NO. 171

AMENDING SECTION II OF ORDINANCE NO. 132 RELATING TO PARKING METERS AND THE USE OF PARKING METERS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough of Clymer:

SECTION 1. That Section II of Ordinance No. 132 be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

It shall be the duty of the police of the Borough to make a report to the Mayor designating the parking meter where any violation of the parking meter ordinances occur, the license number of the vehicle involved in such violation, the time when such vehicle was parked in violation of any of the provisions of the parking meter ordinances, and any other facts which may be necessary in order to secure a clear understanding of the circumstances attending such violation. The police officer making such report also attach to every vehicle a notice that such vehicle was parked in violation of the parking meter ordinances, which notice shall contain instructions to such owner or operator to pay a minimum fine of twenty-five cents (25¢) if deposited in the courtesy box or at the police station within twenty-four (24) hours after the violation occurs. After twenty-four (24) hours the fine will be One Dollar (\$1.00) if paid to the Mayor within fifteen (15) days after the violation occurs.

Any person violating any of the provisions of the parking meter ordinances or who fail to pay the fine as hereinabove set forth shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Two Dollars (\$2.00) nor more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and cost to imprisonment in the Indiana County Jail for not more than five (5) days.

SECTION II. That any ordinance or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
