

ORDINANCE NO. 172

LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING AS A PUBLIC AVENUE IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, AN AVENUE TO BE DESIGNATED AS LOMBARDI AVENUE, AND FIXING AND REGULATING THE WIDTH AND GRADE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough of Clymer as follows:

SECTION 1. That the following avenue, which is hereby designated as Lombardi Avenue, is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public avenue in the Borough of Clymer, which is more particular described as follows:

BEGINING At a point on the north line of Walcott Street at the southeast corner of Lot No. 62 on Walcott Street; thence by the eastern line of said Lot No. 62 North 50° 15' West 150 feet to the southern line of Walnut Avenue; thence by the southern line of Walnut Avenue North 39° 45' East 16 feet to a point on the western line of Lot No. 60 on Walcott Street; thence by the western line of said Lot No. 60 South 50° 15' East 150 feet to the northern line of Walcott Street; thence by the northern line of Walcott Street South 39° 45' West 16 feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2: That the grade of said avenue beginning at the northern line of Walcott Street and proceeding in a northerly direction for 150 feet shall be a descending grade of 15% per centum. The grade as aforesaid shall be for the center line of said avenue.

SECTION 3: That the said avenue shall consist of a central roadway for vehicular traffic sixteen (16) feet in width.

SECTION 4: That the Borough Manger is hereby directed to change the adopted Borough Map as herein directed

SECTION 5: That any ordinance or parts of ordinances conflicting with this ordinance is hereby repealed.
