

## ORDINANCE No. 175

VACATING OF FOURTH STREET BETWEEN ADAMS STREET AND TWO LICK CREEK IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, INDIANA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Nown Council of the Borough of Clymer and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that a portion of Fourth Street between Adams Street and Two Lick Creek in the Borough of Clymer, which is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the southern line of Adams Street at the Northeastern corner of Lot No. 55 on Adams Street; thence by line of said Lot No. 55, South 50° 15' East 150 feet to a point; thence North 39° 45' East 50 feet to a point on the Southwestern corner of Lot No. 53 on Adams Street; thence by line of said Lot No. 53, North 50° 15' West 150 feet to a point on the Southern line of Adams Street; thence by said Street, South 39° 45' East 50m, feet to the place of beginning. be and the same as hereby vacated.

SECTION 2: That the Borough Manager is hereby directed the adopted Borough Map as herein indicated.

SECTION 3. That any Ordinance or part of Ordinance conflicting herewith is hereby repealed.
