

ORDINANCE NO. 178
OF THE
BOROUGH OF CLYMER

AN ORDINANCE OPENING MORRIS STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, BEGINNING AT THE WESTERLY LINE OF EIGHTH STREET AND EXTENDING WESTWARDLY TO THE BOROUGH LINE THENCE NORTHWARDLY TO THE SOUTHERN LINE OF FRANKLIN STREET.

WHEREAS. Vincent Sgricca, being the sole owner of all the abutting properties, has petitioned Borough Council to open certain portions of Morris Street, hereinafter fully described, expressly waiving all claims for damages by reason of said openings.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1: That there is hereby adopted as a part and portion of said Morris Street a street beginning at the Southwestern corner of the intersection of Morris Street and Eighth Street; thence South $49^{\circ} 04'$ West 668.75 feet, more or less, to the Borough Line; thence along said line North $40^{\circ} 56'$ West 50 feet to a point; thence North $49^{\circ} 04'$ East 625.00 feet, more or less, to the Southern line of Eighth Street; thence South $50^{\circ} 15'$ West 50 feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2: That there is hereby adopted as an unnamed Street beginning at the Western end of Morris Street as described in Section 1 above and extending between Lot No. 128 and the Borough Line; thence along the Westerly line of Lots Nos. 128 and 119 in a Northerly direction 360 feet, more or less, to the Southern line of Franklin Street; thence along same in a Westerly direction 100 feet, more or less, to a point; thence in a Southerly direction 237.50 feet, more or less, to the Borough Line; thence South $40^{\circ} 56'$ West 68.75 feet, more or less, to the Northern line of Morris Street; thence along same North $49^{\circ} 04'$ East 18.75 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning. The said Street being approximately 60 feet wide.

SECTION 3: That within ten days after approval of this ordinance notice shall be given by handbills posted along the lines of the proposed improvement stating the fact and date of this ordinance that the petition was signed by a majority in interest and number of owners abutting, and that any person interested and denying the fact that the petition was so signed may appeal to the Court of Common Pleas of Indiana County, within thirty days after the passage thereof.

SECTION 4: That the map or general plan of the Borough be and is changed and modified amended in accordance with Sections 1 and 2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 5: That all ordinances or part of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
