

ORDINANCE NO. 179  
OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER

AN ORDINANCE VACATING NINTH STREET FROM THE SOUTHERN LINE OF MORRIS STREET, SOUTHWARDLY TO THE BOROUGH LINE, AND AN UNNAMED ALLEY BETWEEN EIGHTH STREET AND NINTH STREETS FROM THE SOUTHERN LINE OF OAK STREET SOUTHWARDLY TO THE BOROUGH LINE.

WHEREAS, Vincent Sgriccia, being the sole owner of all abutting properties, has petitioned Borough Council to vacate certain portions of Ninth Street and an unnamed alley hereinafter fully described, expressly waiving all claims for damages by reason of said vacating.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1: That there is hereby vacated, a portion of Ninth Street, that part beginning at the southwestern corner of the intersection of Morris Street and Ninth Street on line of Lot No. 121; thence along the southerly line of Morris Street, North 49° 40' East 50 feet more or less to Lot No. 119; thence along the western line of said lot South 40° 56' East 166 feet more or less to the Borough line; thence along said line South 49° 40' West 50 feet more or less to the eastern line of Lot No. 121; thence along said line North 40° 56' West 166 feet more or less to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2: That there is hereby vacated a portion of an unnamed alley, that part and portion beginning at the southwestern corner of the intersection of Oak Street and unnamed alley on line of Lot No. 114; thence along the southerly line of Oak Street North 49° 40' East 16 feet more or less to Lot No. 112; thence along the western line of Lot Nos. 112 and 111 South 40° 56' East 335 feet more or less to the Borough line; thence along said line South 49° 40' West 16 feet more or less to the eastern line of Lot No. 113; thence along the eastern line of Lot Nos. 113 and 114 North 40° 56' West 330 feet more or less to the place of beginning.

SECTION 3: That within ten days after approval of this ordinance notice shall be given by handbills posted along the lines of the proposed improvement stating the fact and date of this ordinance, that the petition was signed by a majority in interest and number of owners abutting, and that any person interested and denying the fact that the petition was so signed may appeal to the Court of Common Pleas of Indiana County, within thirty days after the passage thereof.

SECTION 4: That the map or general plan of the Borough be and is changed and modified and amended in accordance with Sections 1 and 2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 5; That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
