

ORDINANCE NO. 18

An Ordinance prohibiting the firing or shooting of guns or other instruments throwing bullets or other missiles, and prohibiting the making of bonfires and shooting and exploding fireworks and cartridges, and prescribing penalties for the violation thereof.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer, in the County of Indiana, and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. Any person who shall, within the limits of the Borough, willfully discharge any gun or firearms, except in necessary defense of life or property, or shall explode powder or dynamite in any manner, in any square, street or alley, without permission of the Street Committee, shall, for every such offense, pay a fine or penalty of not less than two nor more than ten dollars and upon judgment against any person by summary conviction of violation of this section, or by proceedings by summons, on default of payment of fine or penalty imposed by said judgment and the costs, the defendant shall be sentenced and committed to the county jail for a period not exceeding thirty days.

Section 2. Any person who shall within the limits of the Borough, willfully discharge any air gun, spring gun or other instrument shooting or throwing shot, bullets, stones or other solid substances, shall for every such offense, pay a fine or penalty of not less than two, nor more than twenty-five dollars and upon judgment against any person by summary conviction of violation of this section, or by proceedings by summons, on default of payment of fine or penalty imposed by said judgment and the costs, the defendant shall be sentenced and committed to the county jail for a period not exceeding thirty days.

Section 3. ✓ No person shall make any bonfire, or shoot or explode any ✓ rockets, firecrackers, or dynamite cartridges on any square, street, or alley within the limits of the Borough; any person violating this section shall pay a fine or penalty of not less than one or more than ten dollars and upon judgment against any person by summary conviction of violation of this section, or by proceedings by summons, on default of payment of fine or penalty imposed by said judgment and the costs, the defendant shall be sentenced and committed to the county jail for a period not exceeding thirty days.
