

ORDINANCE No 181

AN ORDINANCE OF BOROUGH OF CLYMER, INDIANA COUNTY and the  
Commonwelath of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for the year 1975  
BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and ~~the~~ it is hereby ordained and enacted  
by the Bounci~~k~~ of Clymer Borough, County of Indiana, Pennsylv~~an~~ia:

That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and  
occupations within the said municipality subject to taxation for  
fiscal year 1975 as follows:

Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of ---- - - - 15 mills  
on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of - 150 cents  
on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

For debt purposes the sum of - - - - - 12 mills  
on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of - 120 cents  
on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation

Making a total rate for all Borough purposes of Twenty-Seven (27)  
mills.

That any ordinance or part of ordinance, conflicting with this  
ordnance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same  
affects this ordinance.

RESOLUTION.  
A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, INDIANA COUNTY  
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, the Borough of Clymer is a duly constituted political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Clymer is granted the authority to levy, assess and collect such taxes as they shall determine on persons, transactions, occupations, privileges subject and personal property within the limits of such political subdivision, and

WHEREAS, THE Borough of Clymer is further granted the authority, by Ordinance or Resolution, under P. S. Title 53, Section 6902, as amended, to exempt any person whose total income from all sources is less than Three Thousand Two Hundred & 00/100 (\$3200.00) Dollars per annum from the per capita or similar head tax, occupation tax and occupational privilege tax, or any portion thereof, therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved that all persons subject to the taxing authority of the Borough of Clymer, whose total income from all sources is less than Three Thousand Two hundred & 00/100 dollars per annum, are hereby exempt from the per capita or similar head tax, occupation tax, and occupational privilege tax or any portion thereof, provided, that any person desiring such exemptions make application to the local taxing authority, in writing prior to the due date for any such tax.
