

ORDINANCE NO. 183

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF ELDER AVENUE IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, BEGINNING AT THE EASTERLY LINE OF LOT NO. 234 AND EXTENDING ALONG THE COURSE AND DISTANCE OF SAID AVENUE IN A WESTWARD DIRECTION TO THE WESTERLY LINE OF LOT NO. 252, IN CLYMER BOROUGH PLAN OF LOTS.

WHEREAS, the owner or owners of all abutting properties, have petitioned Borough Council to vacate a certain portion of Elder Avenue, hereinafter fully described, expressly waiving all claims for damages by reason of said closing:

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I: That the portion of Elder Avenue bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point North 40 degrees 56 minutes West 52 feet from the intersection of the Easterly line of Lot No. 234 with the Northerly line of Dixon Road in said Plan: thence South 44 degrees 29 minutes West 200 feet, more or less, to a point in Lot No. 240: thence South 78 degrees 55 minutes West 250 feet, more or less, to a point on line of a 16 foot unnamed alley, common with the Westward line of Lot No. 252: thence North 11 degrees 10 minutes West 16 feet to a point: thence North 78 degrees 55 minutes East 240 feet, more or less, in Lot No. 240: thence North 44 degrees 29 minutes East 200 feet, more or less, to a point on the Eastwardly line of Lot 234: thence South 40 degrees 56 minutes East 16 feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION II: That the Borough Engineer is hereby directed to change the adopted Borough map as herein indicated.

SECTION III: That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be hereby repealed.

SECTION IV: That this ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date hereof.
