

ORDINANCE No. 185  
OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF CYPRESS AVENUE IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, BEGINNING AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE SOUTHERLY LINE OF MORRIS STREET IN THE SAID BOROUGH AND EXTENDING IN A SOUTHERLY DIRECTION THROUGH ITS INTERSECTION WITH MAPLE AVENUE, IN THE CLYMER BOROUGH PLAN OF LOTS.

WHEREAS, the owner or owners of all abutting properties, have petitioned Borough Council to vacate a certain portion of Cypress Avenue, herein-after fully described, expressly waiving all claims for damages by reason of said closing:

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I: That the portion of Cypress Avenue bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the southerly line of Morris Street in the aforementioned plan of lots, on line of lot No. 63; thence south 50 degrees 15 minutes East 166 feet to the northerly line of lot. 64; thence along said line south 39 degrees 45 minutes west 16 feet to the easterly end of Maple Avenue; thence along said end line and the easterly line of lot No. 65 north 50 degrees 15 minutes west 166 feet to a point on the southerly line of Morris Street; thence along said line 39 degrees 45 minutes east 16 feet to the place of beginning.

be, and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION II: That the Borough Engineer is directed to change the adopted Borough map as herein indicated.

SECTION III: That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be hereby repealed.

SECTION IV: That this ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date hereof.
