

ORDINANCE NO. 188

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, Indiana County, and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the rate for the year 1976.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana, Pennsylvania:

That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and occupations within the said municipality subject to taxation for the year 1976 as follows:

Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of - - - - - 18 mills on each dollas of assessed valuation, or the sum of - - - 180 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation

For debt purposes, the sum of - - - - - 9 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, on the sum of - - - 90 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

The same being summarized in tabular form as follows:

	Mills on each Dollar of Assessed Valuation	Cents on each One Hundred Dollars of Assessed Valuation
Tax Rate for General Purposes- - - - -	18 mills	180 cents
Tax Rate for Debt Services - - - - -	9 mills	90 cents
Total	27 mills	270 cents

That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed inssofar as the same affects this ordinance.
