

ORDINANCE NO. 190
OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF SHERMAN STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, BEGINNING AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE WESTERLY LINE OF SEVENTH STREET IN THE BOROUGH AND EXTENDING IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION TO TWOLICK CREEK IN THE CLYMER BOROUGH PLAN ~~EE~~ LOTS.

WHEREAS, the owner or owners of all abutting properties, have petitioned Borough Council to vacate a certain portion of Sherman Street, hereinafter fully described, expressly waiving all claims for damages by reason of said closing:

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I: That the portion of Sherman Street bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON the southerly line of Sherman Street in the aforementioned Plan of Lots, at the northeastern corner of Lot No. 91; thence South $39^{\circ} 45'$ West 525 feet, more or less, to the easterly bank of Twolick creek; thence along the course and distance of the said Twolick Creek in a northerly direction to the northerly line of said Sherman Street; thence along said line, North $39^{\circ} 45'$ East 400 feet, more or less, to the southeastern corner of Lot No. 92; thence South $50^{\circ} 15'$ East 50 feet to the place of beginning. be, and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION II. That the Borough Engineer is directed to change the adopted Borough map as herein indicated.

SECTION III. That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. That this ordinance shall become affective thery (30) days after the date hereof.
