

ORDINANCE NO. 191
OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF EIGHTH STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, BEGINNING AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTHERLY LINE OF BEECH AVENUE IN THE BOROUGH AND EXTENDING IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH SHERMAN STREET IN THE CLYMER BOROUGH PLAN OF LOTS.

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WHHEEAS, the owner or owners of all abutting properties, have petitioned Borough Council to vacate a certain portion of Eighth Street, hereinafter fully described, expressly waiving all claims for damages by reason of said closing.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I. That the portion of Eighth Street bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the easterly line of Eighth Street in the aforementioned Plan of Lots, at the southwestern corner of Lot No. 105; thence South 39° 45' East 50 feet to the southeastern corner of Lot. 107; thence along the westerly line of Eighth Street; North 50° 15' West 150 feet to the southerly line of Sherman Street; thence along said line, North 39° 45' East 50 feet to the easterly line of Eighth Street; thence South 50° 15' East 150 feet to the place of beginning.

be, and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION II. That the Borough Engineer is directed to change the adopted Borough Map as herein indicated.

SECTION III. That any ordinance of part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. That this ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date hereof.
