

ORDINANCE NO. 192  
OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER.

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF HINES STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, BEGINNING AT THE EASTERLY LINE OF LOTS NOS. 279 AND 278 IN THE BOROUGH AND EXTENDING IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION TO THE END AT THE WESTERLY LINE OF LOTS NOS. 299 AND 298, IN THE CLYMER BOROUGH PLAN OF LOTS.

WHEREAS, the owner or owners of all abutting properties, have petitioned borough of clymer to vacate a certain portion of hines street, hereinafter fully described, expressly waiving all claims for damages by reason of said closing:

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I. That the portion of Hines Street bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the southerly line of Hines Street in the aforementioned Plan of Lots, at the northeastern corner of Lot No. 279; thence South  $78^{\circ} 55'$  West 550 feet, more or less, to the northwestern corner of Lot No. 299; thence North  $11^{\circ} 10'$  West to the southwestern corner of Lot No. 298; thence along the northerly line of said Hines Street, North  $78^{\circ} 55'$  East 550 feet, more or less, to a point at the southeastern corner of Lot No. 278; thence South  $11^{\circ} 10'$  East 50 feet to the place of beginning.

BE, AND THE SAME IS HEREBY VACATED.

SECTION II. That the Borough Engineer is directed to change the adopted Borough map as herein indicated/

SECTION III: That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be hereby repealed.

SECTION IV: That this ordinance shall become effective thirty days after the date hereof.
