

ORDINANCE NO. 193

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, designating portions of certain streets "safety zones", regulating the speed of traffic thereon and providing a penalty for violation thereof.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Clymer, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

SECTION ONE: The entirety of Hines Street in the Borough of Clymer; Seventh Street between Franklin Street and Sherman Street in the Borough of Clymer; Beech Avenue between Seventh Street and Eighth Street in the Borough of Clymer; and Eighth Street between Franklin Street and Beech Avenue; are hereby designated as "safety zones" due to their proximity to playground areas and frequent use by children.

SECTION TWO: No vehicle shall proceed at a speed in excess of ten (10) miles an hour within the above described "safety zones".

SECTION THREE: The speed limit so established shall be indicated by the erection of official signs, spaced not less than one-eighth (1/8) of a mile apart, on the right hand of the street facing the traffic to be controlled, and at the end of the speed zone there shall be an official sign indicating the end of such speed zone.

SECTION FOUR: Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction before a magistrate be sentenced to pay a fine of Thirty-five & 00/100 (\$35.00) dollars and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for not more than five (5) days.

SECTION FIVE: Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance conflicting with this Ordinance is hereby repealed in so far as the same effects this Ordinance.
