

ORDINANCE NO. 208

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 162 AS IT RELATES TO THE PARKING PRIVILEGES ON BOROUGH STREETS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Clymer, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same;

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance no. 162 shall be and is hereby amended to be referred to as Section 1, Subsection (a), and further, that two additional subsections shall be added which shall be referred to as subsection (b) and (c) and shall read as follows:

- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on Sixth Street between the hours of 2:00 o'clock a.m. and 6:00 o'clock a.m.
- (c) It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on the southern side of Morris Street between Eighth and Third Streets, on the northerly side of Hancock Street between Sixth and Second Streets and on the southern side of Sage Street.
