

ORDINANCE NO. 221

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, INCREASING THE PER CAPITA TAX TO TEN (\$10.00) DOLLARS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, an it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Clymer, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that Section 1, and Section 1 only of Ordinance No. 103 be amended to read the following:

SECTION 1. That from and after the enactment and approval hereof, there is hereby levied in the Borough of Clymer, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, under the provisions of the Laws of Pennsylvania, an annual per capita tax of TEN (\$10.00) DOLLARS on each and every person, male and female, of the age of Eighteen (18) and upwards, residing within and being a resident of the said Borough, which tax shall be in addition to and not included in or considered a part of the regular annual tax levy.

SECTION 2. That any ordinance, or part of an ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance amending Ordinance No. 103 be and same is hereby repealed as same affects this ordinance.
