

ORDINANCE NO. 222

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA,  
FIXING THE FEES FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted  
by the Council of the Borough of Clymer, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
that Ordinance No. 89 be amended to read the following:

SECTION 1.

That the third paragraph of Section III of Ordinance No. 89 shall  
be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

To a vehicle which occupies a metered parking space after a notice  
of violation has been attached without the owner or operator having  
deposited a coin or coins in the meter shall be attached additional  
notice for each hour the vehicle remains over parked. Said notice  
shall specify the offense, and shall instruct the owner or operator  
that the sum of Two (\$2.00) dollard must be paid for each such  
violation to the Mayor of the Borough of Clymer or must be placed  
in the envelope provided with said notice and deposited in containers  
attached to certain parking meters in the Borough of Clymer within  
Twenty-Four (24) hours. That if payment as heretofore specified is  
not made, the owner or operator receiving such notice shall make  
the payment of the sum of Five (\$5.00) dollars to the Mayor of the  
Borough of Clymer within Fifteen (15) days from the date of violation.

In addition, parking fines are imposed for the following actions:

- (1) Double parking; \$5.00 per violation
- (2) Blocking alley; \$5.00 per violation
- (3) Blocking highway; \$5.00 per violation
- (4) Fire hydrant; \$5.00 per violation
- (5) No Parking Zone; \$5.00 per violation
- (6) Improper parking; \$5.00 per violation
- (7) Yellow line (not parking with yellow line designation);  
\$5.00 per violation
- (8) Official Signs (damaging); \$5.00 per violation
- (9) 2 A.M. to 6 A.M. (parking on Franklin & Sixth Streets);  
\$5.00 per violation

SECTION 2.

Any ordinance or parts of ordinances conflicting with this  
ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
