

ORDINANCE NO. 224

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE FIXING OF THE FEES FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Clymer, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that Ordinance No. 89 be amended to read the following:

Section I.

That the following paragraphs be added to the end of Section III of Ordinance No. 89:

If any of the following parking violations are not paid within a period of Fifteen (15) days from issuance, a delinquency charge shall be assessed against the owner or operator of the violating motor vehicle in the following amounts:

- (A) A Fifty cent (.50¢) violation shall increase to Two (\$2.00) dollars.
- (B) A Two (\$2.00) dollar violation shall increase to Five (\$5.00) dollars.
- (C) A Five (\$5.00) dollar violation shall increase to Ten (\$10.00) dollars.

In addition, if any of the above three (3) violations with delinquency charges is not paid within thirty (30) days from the date of issuance of the original violation, an additional penalty shall be assessed in the following amounts:

- (A) A Two (\$2.00) dollar fine (consisting of a 50¢ violation and a \$1.50 delinquency charge) shall increase to Ten (\$10.00) dollars.
- (B) A Five (\$5.00) dollar fine (consisting of a \$2.00 violation and a \$3.00 delinquency charge) shall increase to Fifteen (\$15.00) dollars.
- (C) A Ten (\$10.00) dollar fine (consisting of a \$5.00 violation and a \$5.00 delinquency charge) shall increase to Twenty (\$20.00) dollars.

Section II.

That the following paragraphs be added to the end of Section III of Ordinance No. 89 and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any person owning a motor vehicle and desiring to obtain from the Clymer Borough a "Parking Permit", which shall grant the purchaser the right to park at metered spaces within a designated area in the Borough without having to deposit coins in the parking meter, may obtain such for an amount of Fifteen (\$15.00) dollars per month. The permit shall contain the vehicle's registration number and shall allow that vehicle, and only that vehicle, to park at any meter space within the Borough, except on Franklin Street between Fifth and Sixth Streets, without a parking fine, penalty or citation being issued. The permit application, which must be accompanied by payment in full, shall contain the applicant's name and address, along with the model, make, color and year of the motor vehicle for which the permit is to apply. The permit shall be null and void upon its expiration.

Section III.

Any ordinance of parts of ordinances conflicting with this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
