

ORDINANCE NO. 226

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA
AMENDING THE FIXING OF THE FEES FOR AMUSEMENT DEVICES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by
the Council of the Borough of Clymer, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that
Ordinance No. 107 be amended to read the following:

Section I.

That the following paragraph shall amend Section 6 and Section 11 of
Ordinance No. 107:

Section 6: No license for any billard or pool table, shuffle board,
bowling alley or mechanical amusement device shall be issued until any
license fee thereof shall have been paid by the applicant to the borough
treasurer in the sum of Thirty-five (\$35.00) dollars for each and every
device so installed or used, under the terms of this ordinance in the
borough, which amount paid as aforesaid shall be a license fee until
December 31 of each year, however should any device be installed after
July 1, or any year, and application therefor be made after said date,
then in such event the license for that particular year shall be the
sum of Seventeen and 50/100 (\$17.50) dollars to December 31.

Section II.

Any ordinance or parts of ordinances conflicting with this ordinance
is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
