

ORDINANCE NO. 239

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON CERTAIN STREETS IN THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER AND PROVIDING PENALTIES AND VIOLATIONS FOR THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted that the following paragraphs shall be added to Section 1 of Ordinance No. 163 and in all other respects said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect:

It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on Second Street from Franklin Street to Hancock Street, on Hancock Street from First Street to Second Street and on First Street between Hancock Street and the Borough line on the South side of First Street.

This Ordinance shall take effect on enactment and approval.
