

ORDINANCE NO. 246

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 89 and Ordinance No. 132 as amended in regard to overtime violations.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Borough Council for the Borough of Clymer, it is ordained and enacted as follows:

Section 3 of Ordinance No. 89 and Section 2 of Ordinance No. 132 are hereby amended to read as follows;

Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance as amended or aiding and abetting or assisting in the violation thereof shall upon conviction thereof for the first violation shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$1.00 plus costs of prosecution and in the default of the payment of the such fine and costs, imprisonment for not more than five days. For any second violation occurring in the same day said violator upon conviction, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$2.00 together with costs of prosecution and in default of payment of the such fine and costs, imprisonment for not more than five days. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance for a third time or any subsequent time during the same twenty-four hour period, shall be sentenced, upon conviction, to pay a fine of \$5.00 together with costs of prosecution and in default of payment of the such fine and costs, imprisonment for not more than five days.

Providing that the police officers of the Borough shall place a parking ticket with an applicable notice upon each vehicle parked at a parking meter indicating that the period of legal parking shall have elapsed and the owner or operator of said vehicle shall have the privilege, before midnight of the date of issue of the placing of said parking ticket with the sum of \$1.00 in the United States Mail or turning in said ticket and the sum of \$1.00 to the Borough Police Station in full satisfaction of such violation and in such case shall prosecution be held for such violation. Provided further that the placement of one parking ticket upon the vehicle shall not excuse the continuance of over-parking and the police officer shall have the authority to place additional parking tickets upon any such vehicle in accordance with this Ordinance.

In all other respects, Ordinance No. 89 and Ordinance 132, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
