

ORDINANCE NO. 257

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COUNTY OF INDIANA AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING VARIOUS BUILDING CODE ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE THAT THE CURRENT EDITION OF EACH RESPECTIVE CODE SHALL BE AUTOMATICALLY ADOPTED AS THE RESPECTIVE CODE FOR CLYMER BOROUGH AND PROVIDING FURTHER THAT THE PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY SAID ORDINANCE SHALL BE \$300.00 FOR EACH OFFENSE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

1. The BOCA Building Code which was adopted by Ordinance No. 214, the BOCA Basic Plumbing Code which was adopted by Ordinance No. 215, the National Electric Code that was adopted by Ordinance No. 216, the BOCA Property Maintenance Code that was adopted by Ordinance No. 217 and BOCA Fire Prevention Code that was adopted by Ordinance No. 218 are hereby amended to provide that the Borough of Clymer does hereby adopt by reference the Code edition of each of said codes as each is published and that each edition as shall be subsequently published shall automatically become the applicable Code for the Borough of Clymer.

2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of any of the aforementioned Codes or Ordinances, as amended, or shall fail to comply therewith, or who shall violate or fail to comply with any order thereunder, or to do anything in violation of any certificate or permit issued thereunder, or who shall fail to comply with any order of the Borough Council or any court of competent jurisdiction within the time fixed therein, for each and every violation for failure to comply, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$300.00, together with costs, or to undergo imprisonment for a period of not more than 30 days. Each violation or failure to comply with any provisions or Ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

3. These amendments are effective upon adoption and any provisions of the aforementioned Ordinances that are in conflict with these amendments shall be of no force and effect.
