

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COUNTY OF INDIANA, AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE USE OF APPROVED DEVICES FOR ENFORCEMENT OF THE PENNSYLVANIA VEHICLE CODE BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF CLYMER BOROUGH.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

SECTION 1

It shall be lawful, and the Police Department of the Borough of Clymer is hereby authorized, to use, in the Borough of Clymer, any and all electrical, mechanical or electronic speed timing devices which are now or shall hereafter be approved by the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including but not limited to the Robic Acutrak Speed Chronometer, Model SC-800, as a traffic control device, and all future models of this or similar devices, either electrical, mechanical or electronic, for which its intended purpose is to determine the speeds of vehicles.

SECTION 2

Any device used must first be approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation and shall be utilized in accordance with the guidelines or requirements set by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for its use.

SECTION 3

Either temporary or permanent signs shall be posted on any street or highway, in the Borough of Clymer, upon which such electrical, mechanical or electronic speed timing device is being used. Such signs shall give notice of the enforcement of speed restrictions by use of such device and shall refer to this Ordinance as authorizing such devices.

SECTION 4

If any section, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by

any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion of this Ordinance shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such provision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5

Any Ordinance, or part of any Ordinance, which conflicts with the provision of this Ordinance, being in the same, hereby is repealed to the extent of the conflict.
