

ORDINANCE NO. 28

An Ordinance adopting a general plan of the streets and alleys of the Borough of Clymer, including those which have been or may be laid out but not opened, requiring all subdivisions of property to conform thereto, and ordaining that the streets and alleys marked upon said draft or plan and for the first time located as streets and alleys, shall be streets and alleys of said Borough.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer, in the County of Indiana, and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the draft or plan of the lines, roads, streets, lanes and alleys of said Borough and including the streets and alleys which have been or may be laid out but not opened, shall be the general plan of the streets and alleys of said Borough, and all subdivisions of property hereafter made in said Borough shall conform thereto.

Section 2. That the streets and alleys marked upon said draft or plan, for the first time located as streets and alleys, are hereby ordained streets and alleys of said Borough, and no person shall hereafter be entitled to recover any damages for any building or improvements of any kind which shall or may be placed or constructed upon or within the lines of any located street or alley.
