

ORDINANCE NO. 287

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COUNTY OF INDIANA AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 282 THAT WAS PASSED ON DECEMBER 2, 1998, ESTABLISHING THE REAL ESTATE TAX AND AN INCREASE IN THE STREET LIGHT TAX FOR THE YEAR 1999 AND THEREAFTER:

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

1. The real estate tax levied on real estate within the Borough of Clymer shall remain 20 mills on real estate subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the year 1999 and hereafter.
2. The street light tax levied on real estate within the borough of Clymer shall be increased to 6 mills on real estate subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the year 1999 and thereafter.
3. This Ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1999 and the tax rate set forth herein shall continue from year to year until changed by the Borough Council of Clymer Borough.
