

ORDINANCE NO. 298

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COUNTY OF INDIANA AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 293 ESTABLISHING A THREE MILL TAX ON REAL ESTATE FOR FIRE PROTECTION, A REAL ESTATE TAX OF 18 MILLS, AND A STREET LIGHT TAX OF 5 MILLS FOR THE YEAR 2000 AND THEREAFTER

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

That Ordinance No. 293 be amended as follows:

2. The real estate tax levied on real estate within the Borough of Clymer shall be increased from 18 to 21 mills on real estate subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the year 2001 and hereafter.

Except as amended herein, each and every other provision of Ordinance No. 293 shall remain in full force and effect.

**AND WHEREAS**, The Clymer Borough Council recognizes the Clymer Days Festival Committee as an organization which benefits the community as a whole;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:**
