

ORDINANCE NO. 299

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COUNTY OF INDIANA AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA PROHIBITING AND LIMITING THE USE OF SLEDS, SKATEBOARDS AND ROLLER BLADES AND SIMILAR CONVEYANCES ON THE SIDEWALKS AND STREETS OF THE BOROUGH

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

SECTION 1: No person shall coast, ride upon or propel himself upon any sled, skateboard, roller skates, roller blades or similar devices upon any public street or way in the Borough of Clymer.

SECTION 2: No person shall coast or ride upon any sled or similar device on any public sidewalk in the Borough of Clymer, except children may be pulled upon a sled by a person over the age of eighteen (18).

SECTION 3: Any person riding, coasting or propelling himself upon a skateboard, roller skates, roller blades or similar device on any public sidewalk in the Borough of Clymer shall yield the right-of-way to all pedestrians or any motor vehicles lawfully upon or crossing such public sidewalk.

SECTION 4: Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), together with the costs of prosecution; and in default of payment of the fine and costs, imprisonment for not more than three (3) days.


SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be effective immediately.
