

ORDINANCE NO. 300

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COUNTY OF INDIANA AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA TO ESTABLISH FIFTH STREET AS A ONE-WAY ROADWAY**

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

**SECTION 1. ONE-WAY ROADWAY ESTABLISHED.**

Pursuant to the provisions of 75 Pa. C.S. Section 3308 and 6109(a)(4) relating to one-way roadways, that from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the following is hereby established as a one-way roadway:

<b>Roadway</b>	<b>From</b>	<b>To</b>	<b>Direction of Travel</b>
Fifth Street	Franklin Street	Sherman Street	North

**SECTION 2. PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS.**

Any person who shall operate a vehicle upon the roadway or portion thereof hereby established as a one-way roadway other than in the direction hereby established for traffic thereon shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine, which fine shall be set consistent with the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania.

**SECTION 3.** The Clymer Borough Council shall erect and install, or cause to be erected and installed, an official sign bearing the words: **"One Way"**. The said sign shall be installed on the entrance to Fifth Street.


