

ORDINANCE NO. 303

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COUNTY OF INDIANA AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, RENAMING CERTAIN STREETS**


**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

1. Sixth Street from Twolick Bridge to Penn Street shall be known as Sixth Street Extension.
2. State Route 286 shall be known as Franklin Street within the Borough of Clymer.
3. The street extending from the current State Route 286 to Rodney Street shall now be known as Tenth Street.
4. Ash Avenue shall now be renamed Fifteenth Street.
5. Crabtree Avenue shall now be known as Dixon Road.
6. The portion of Stockton Street from Crabtree Avenue, now known as Dixon Road, to the existing Dixon Road shall now become Dixon Road.
7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
