

ORDINANCE NO. 307

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COUNTY OF INDIANA  
AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA PROHIBITING THE DEVELOPMENT  
OF GAS WELLS WITHIN CLYMER BOROUGH

WHEREFORE, the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer opposes the  
development of gas wells within Clymer Borough;

WHEREFORE, allowing development of gas wells could develop a possible  
adverse effect to the quantity and quality of water which serves Clymer Borough;

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of  
Clymer, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

**SECTION 1:** No person, agent, company, corporation or agency shall be  
permitted to develop a gas well within Clymer Borough.

**SECTION 2:** Any person who shall violate this Ordinance shall, upon  
conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of up to Three Hundred Dollars  
(\$300.00) per day and/or up to ninety (90) days' imprisonment per incident. Each day  
shall be considered a separate incident.

2002.


